CALL TO ORDER:

The meeting was called to order at 6:04 PM by Chairman Ryan Perry.

ROLL CALL:

Present were: Mr. Perry, Ms. Cooney, Ms. Hale, Ms. Haas, Mr. Hill.

Motion to Excuse: Ms. McIntosh, Ms. Fry was made by Ms. Hale seconded by Ms. Cooney.

1. Discussion to establish the 2021 Fall Festival date –

Postponed until next Mtg. Ms. McIntosh is gathering information on the bands and their availability. Approved by Ms. Cooney seconded by Ms. Hale. Mr. Hill mentioned considering October 2nd or the 9th for this Festival. Mr. Perry stated he did not want the date to conflict with Oktoberfest and fit in with the bands.

2. Discussion on the possibility of Murals in the City –

Mr. Perry led the discussion on this and stated this came about from a council meeting where a youth came to the meeting and talk about the Edgewood School District or other art programs creating murals around the city on buildings. After CM Nichols and Mr. Perry discussed this, he asked if the Parks Board would like to head this. Mr. Perry asked what the board thought. Mr. Hill and Ms. Cooney like the idea. Ms. Hale stated that the murals should be properly maintained and suggested there should be approval of the design. Mr. Perry stated before any painting was done, run the design through the Parks

Board and staff then run it by counsel. Maybe even a public hearing on this so citizens could weigh in on it. Mr. Hill would like to speak to someone about the maintenance and getting a feel for the life span of a mural. Mr. Perry stated that he would like to resume the in person meeting next time at the city building. We have the proper protocols in place for social distancing. He asked the board if they were okay with meeting in person. Ms. Hale stated she was provided there were no major shifts with COVID 19. Mr. Perry will look into having someone come in and speak about the murals at our next meeting.

REPORTS BY THE BOARD OR CITY ADMINISTRATORS:

Backboards in park – Mr. Perry informed all that they were taken down due to COVID, but will be put back in place soon. Mr. Leichman reported that he just received a text from Mr. Baker that stated they would be installed by 10:00 AM tomorrow morning. Ms. Haas asked about the play area being re-opened. Mr. Perry stated the play area has caution tape taken down right now, however, the city is adhering to the Governors orders at this time.
